Your **finances** mean all the money your business has.



You can pay other people to help manage your finances.

A **bookkeeper** can



 manage money coming into and out of your business



• do your banking



pay your staff.



An **accountant** can

• prepare finance reports



• give you business and finance advice



help you with tax.

Get help to pay tax



You need to pay tax to the Australian

Taxation Office. It is also called the ATO.



The ATO is part of the government.

If you have money problems



A **financial counsellor** can make a plan to fix your money problems.



It is free to talk to a financial counsellor.



They will not tell anyone that you talked to them.
