This document shows the questions included in the online application form for this Carbon Capture Technologies Program Stage 1- EOI. It will help you prepare your responses and the mandatory attachments you need before you apply online.

# Instructions

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The online form captures the information required by the department to assess and manage your application for services and funding.

The first page of the EOI page contains the following instructions.

## Completing your EOI

The EOI consists of separate pages as shown in the navigation menu on the left hand side of the portal page. You can navigate between pages using the menu or the buttons at the bottom of each page.

A red asterisk \* indicates a mandatory question. A warning message may appear if you have not completed all the mandatory questions or if there is an issue with information you have entered.

## Saving your responses

You can save your changes at any time by using the Save button.

To prevent you losing your work you should save often. The portal will time out after 30 minutes if you do not save. Typing or moving your mouse does not reset the time out.

You must use the Save and Continue button to validate the information on each page. If you use the menu to navigate between pages, you will be prompted on the final page to go back and validate all the information you have entered. A green tick indicates a validated page.

You can modify saved responses up until you submit your application.

## Participants

You may invite others to assist in completing your EOI via the application summary page. To do this:

- Select the Participants button
- Enter the details

An email will be sent to the participant inviting them to assist with your EOI.

## Submitting your EOI

You must complete every page of the EOI before you can submit.

You must also read and agree to the declaration which advises you of your responsibilities.

Check all your answers before you submit your EOI. After you submit, it will no longer be editable.

## A. Program selection

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Before you start your EOI, we need to first identify what type of entity is applying.

If you are a trustee applying on behalf of a trust we will need details of both the trust and trustee.

Before you start you should have the following details ready if they are applicable to you.

- Australian Business Number (ABN)

- Indigenous Corporation Number
- Australian Registered Body Number
- Australian Registered Scheme Number
- Incorporated Association Registration

### A.1. Program selection

You must select from a drop-down menu the program you are applying for. If you have been provided with an Invitation code, you will be able to enter it here which will select the program for you.

- Field 1 select – Carbon Capture Technologies Program Stage 1 – Expression of Interest
- Field 2 select - Carbon Capture Technologies Program Stage 1 – Expression of Interest

*When you have selected the program, the following text will appear.*

This grant opportunity will run over 8 years from 2023-24 to 2030-31.

Up to \$65 million is available for this grant opportunity.

The objectives of the program are to:

- accelerate the development of emerging priority CO<sub>2</sub> capture technologies, including Direct Air Capture (DAC), Bio-Energy with Carbon Capture and Storage (BECCS) and/or CO<sub>2</sub> utilisation technologies
- support RD&D to advance technological and commercial readiness of CCUS in hard-to-abate industries such as cement, chemicals and steel
- demonstrate verifiable permanence of CO<sub>2</sub> sequestered via a range of utilisation applications
- support global CCUS capability development.

The minimum grant amount is \$1 million and the maximum is \$15 million.

You should read the [grant opportunity guidelines](#) and [sample grant agreements](#) before filling out this EOI. We recommend you keep the guidelines open as you are completing your EOI so you can refer to them when providing your responses.

You may submit your EOI at any time up until 5.00pm AEDT on 31 October 2023. Please take account of time zone differences when submitting your EOI.

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## B. Eligibility

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We will ask you the following questions to establish your eligibility for the Carbon Capture Technologies Program grant opportunity.

*Questions marked with an asterisk are mandatory.*

- Do you have an Australian Business Number (ABN)? \*

- a corporate Commonwealth entity
- none of the above

*You must select one of the eligible options from a drop-down menu to proceed to the next question.*

- Can you confirm that your project is not seeking to achieve carbon sequestration via nature-based solutions, such as agro-forestry, blue carbon, soil carbon sequestration or ocean alkalinisation? \*

*You must answer yes to proceed to the next question.*

- Can you confirm that your project is not seeking to sequester and use carbon dioxide for the purposes of enhanced petroleum recovery? \*

*You must answer yes to proceed to the next question.*

- Can you confirm that your project is not seeking support for activities associated with the use and sequestration of carbon dioxide due to fossil fuel production or energy generation? \*

*You must answer yes to proceed to the next section.*

## C. Applicant address

### E.1. Project title and description

### E.3. Project duration

*Your project must be completed by 30 March 2031, the maximum project duration is 82 months.*

### E.4. Project location

## F. Project budget

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### F.1. Project budget summary

Provide a summary of your eligible project expenditure over the life of the project.

*If you are registered for GST, enter the GST exclusive amount. If you are not registered for GST, enter the GST inclusive amount. We only provide grant funding based on eligible expenditure. Refer to the guidelines for guidance on eligible expenditure.*

*The grant amount will be up to 75 per cent of eligible project expenditure with the minimum project expenditure for this grant opportunity being \$1.33 million.*

## G. Assessment criteria

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We will assess your EOI based on the weighting given to each criterion and against the indicators listed beneath each criterion.

*The amount of detail and supporting evidence you provide should be commensurate with the project size, complexity and grant amount requested. You should define, quantify, and provide evidence to support your answers.*

*If you are successful in the EOI stage, you will be able to refine your responses based on feedback in Stage 2.*

### G.1. Assessment criterion 1 (50 points)

*Your response is limited to 5000 characters including spaces and does not support formatting.*

#### Alignment with program objectives

You must demonstrate this by identifying:

- how your project will contribute to the research, development or demonstration of CCUS approaches capable of addressing emissions from hard-to-abate industrial sources or drawing CO<sub>2</sub> from the air
- the novelty of your technologies and its scalability by 2050
- how your project will increase Australia's knowledge and capabilities in CCUS
- the extent to which the proposed technologies can drive deployment of CCUS across a range of industrial applications
- the amount of permanent abatement that results from your project, both in absolute terms and as a proportion of overall carbon emissions from the CO<sub>2</sub> source. For capture projects, this may include any offtake arrangements with utilisation or storage project partners.

### G.2. Assessment criterion 2 (30 points)

*Your response is limited to 5000 characters including spaces and does not support formatting.*

#### Capacity, capability and resources to deliver the project

You must demonstrate this by identifying:

- your track record in managing similar projects and access to personnel with the right skills and experience, including management and technical staff
- the involvement of any domestic or international project partners, including their track record and the capability they will add to your project
- how your partnerships will work together to achieve your project outcomes
- how you will ensure safe operations, apply industry best practices, ensure regulatory compliance and public assurance
- your plan to manage the project, address governance, scope, implementation plan, timeframes, budget risks and contingencies
- your access, or future plans to access, any infrastructure, capital equipment, technologies, intellectual property and required regulatory or other approvals
- your ability to extend or expand the project beyond the grant funding, if needed.
