



### Fact sheet

The Anti-Dumping Commission (Commission) administers Australia's anti-dumping system. The International Trade Remedies Advisory (ITRA) Service assists small to medium sized businesses (SMEs) access Australia's anti-dumping system.

Anti-dumping measures help Australian industry facing injury from dumped imports.

### Australian SME importers

Are you looking to import goods for the first time or change the source of your imported goods?

A number of imported goods attract special duties of Customs known as dumping duties and countervailing duties.

Dumping duties and countervailing duties are on certain countries only, and rates of duty can differ between exporters.

Are you importing goods and paying dumping and/or countervailing duties?

### Australian SME manufacturers

Are imports that you suspect are 'dumped' injuring your business?

Dumping is when the export price of imported goods is less than the normal value. Usually this is the selling price of those goods in the country of export.
